

- All games will use a 20-minute clock. The clock will run continually. Half-time at 10 minutes.
- Teams are asked to wear shirts of matching color.
- The game's first possession will be determined by a coin toss conducted by the referee.
- No stalling of any type is allowed.
- Each team is allowed one time-out per game (45 seconds) while the 20-minute clock continues to run. No timeouts in the last 2 minutes of the game.
- Substitutions are allowed only on dead ball situations. The clock will continue to run so do this quickly.
- Play starts from the "X". No defense is allowed after a change of possession while the offense is taking the ball back to the "X". This includes after a rebound or made baskets. Play will not restart until the ball is at the "X".
- You must pass or dribble the ball from the "X" before you shoot. The defense has to stay behind the designated line until the ball handler dribbles or passes on a possession. You cannot dribble once on the "X" and shoot, you have to move off the "X".
- Tie Breaking Procedure: If a game remains tied after the time limit has expired, 3 members of each team will shoot a bonus free throw. If both teams make the same amount on the first try, both teams will have three players shoot each round until one team makes more free throws than the other.
- Individual players can only play for one team.
- Each team may have up to 4 players.
